

SPECIAL DAYS IN THE CHURCH CALENDAR THIS WEEK

Monday 9th August: St Teresa Benedicta of the Cross
(Edith Stein) born 1891 in

Wroclaw, Poland, the youngest of seven children of a
Jewish family. A brilliant student, she gained her
doctorate in philosophy at the age of 25. Became a
Catholic in 1922 and a Carmelite nun. Both Jewish and
Catholic she fled to Holland when the Nazis came to
power but was captured and sent to Auschwitz where
she died in a gas chamber on 9 August 1942. This is
also the anniversary of Fr Hugh Mullan who was shot
by soldiers while carrying out his priestly duties in
Ballymurphy. We pray for all the victims in what has
become known as the Ballymurphy Massacre, 1971.

Tuesday 10th August: Saint Lawrence. The saying “as
happy as Larry” came from today’s saint. He was a
cheerful giver and one of seven deacons martyred in
Rome in 258.

Wednesday 11th August: Saint Clare. Born in Assisi
1193. She followed St Francis in his life of poverty. She
was the founder and ruler of the Poor Clares.

Saturday 14th August: St Maximilian Kolbe, Franciscan,
who worked in the apostolate of the press in Poland
and Japan. Died in Auschwitz 1941.

YOUTH WORKER – 3 YEAR FIXED TERM CONTRACT: Triangle Parishes Project- Coleraine/Portstewart/Portrush

We are seeking to recruit a motivated and talented
individual who will be responsible for the implementation
of the Triangle Parishes Project (TPP,) for the purpose of
impacting the lives of children and young people.
This entails four key areas for the development of projects
and initiatives: 1. Faith development initiatives.
2. Community relations initiatives. 3. Work in Youth
Centres. 4. Community services such as job creation and
skills development. The post will be based within
Portstewart Parish Office with a reporting line to the
Triangle Parishes Committee. We see this as an excellent
opportunity and challenge for an experienced Youth
Worker to join our Diocesan Team. Terms are based on a 3-
year Fixed Term Contract appointment requiring 37.5 hours
attendance each week. Flexibility in work pattern in
respect of evening and weekend working will also be a
requirement of this role. Salary: £24,000 gross per annum.

PARISH SECRETARY (part time) PORTRUSH PARISH

The post holder will be required to: •provide confidential,
efficient and effective secretarial support to the Parish
Priest, and assistance to visitors and parishioners who visit
or make contact with the Parish office. •effectively and
efficiently manage and maintain the Parish Office.
The terms are based on a permanent appointment
requiring 12 hours per week, work pattern to be agreed.
Rate of Pay - £10.50 gross per hour.

CARETAKER PORTRUSH PARISH

Responsibilities will include: ensuring the Church, Parish
Hall and Church grounds are maintained to the highest
standard; are clean, safe, secure, and welcoming to all who
use them; opening and closing the Church and Parish Hall
and reporting all maintenance issues identified to the
Parish Priest. The terms are based on a permanent
appointment requiring 16 hours attendance each week,
work pattern to be agreed. Ability to work flexible hours is
required from the post holder from time to time. Rate of
Pay - £8.91 gross per hour.
