
### PARISH NOVENA TO ST JOSEPH

The Season of Creation is a critical moment for Catholics to lift up the voices of the most vulnerable and advocate on their behalf ahead of the important summits, the UN Summit on Biodiversity (COP 15) in October and the UN Climate Summit in November (COP 26). Bishop Treanor invites you to join advocacy initiatives

The season of creation closes on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> October, the Feast of St Francis of Assisi. He shows us just how inseparable the bond is between concern for nature, justice for the poor, commitment to society, and interior peace.'
