In Portstewart, as in all parishes in the Diocese of Down and Connor, we have a Safeguarding Committee which is responsible for ensuring that best practice in child and vulnerable adult protection are in place in our parish. Our work is guided by the policy and standards set by the National Board for Safeguarding Children

in the Catholic Church in Ireland. The Covid pandemic has had a massive impact on us all as individuals, families, parish communities and parish groups. As a consequence, we have become disconnected with parish activities. We look forward now with hope to a time when we can open up parish groups again. The Safeguarding Committee will be involved in the recruitment and vetting of volunteers and group leaders and will offer support and encouragement to all those working with children in our parish.
