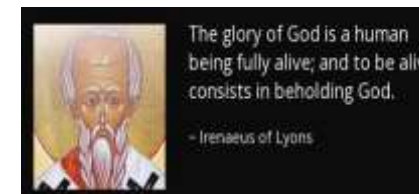


APOSTOLIC WORK

Masses, please contact Bernadette ☎ 07941 733502**

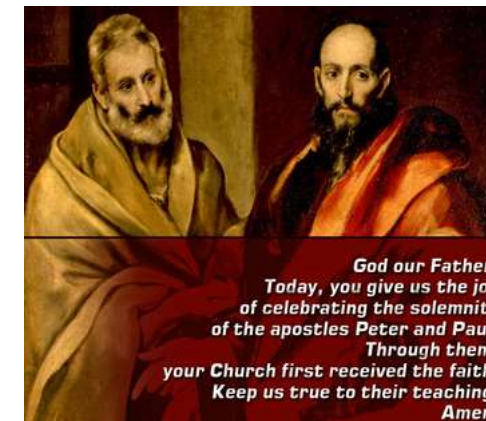

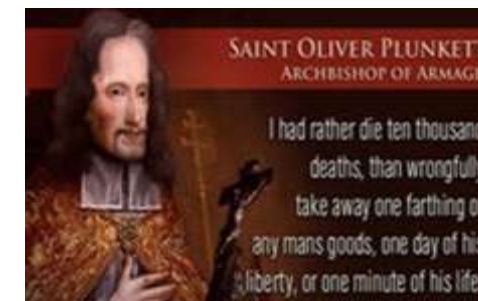
