CELEBRATION OF THE SACRAMENTS

Arrangements are being finalised for the celebration of First Confession, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation next year. Children attending St. Colum's Primary School in Portstewart and St. Patrick's Primary School in Portrush are already enrolled for these sacraments and will undertake their preparation in school.
