#### **FORTY HOURS**

As part of our celebrations of the Jubilee year, our local family of parishes are holding Forty Hours of Eucharistic Adoration. Organised jointly by the parishes of

Coleraine, Ballymoney, Portrush & Portstewart, it will run from 7am on Thursday 3rd April to 11pm on Friday 4th at St Malachy's, Coleraine. The Blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist will be exposed continuously for private prayer and adoration day & night.

7pm: Penitential Service Friday 4th April 3am: Guided Holy Hour 7am: Mass 10am: Mass



7pm: Guided Holy Hour with Stations of the Cross 10.30pm: Closing Devotions & Benediction

The rest of the time will be for quiet prayer and Adoration. You can call in at any time to spend as long or as short a period of prayer as you wish. The most important thing to do is simply to come. If you are uncertain what to do or how to begin, just come. Christ is waiting to shower you with mercy and grace. You just have to show up to receive it! After entering the church, bless yourself with holy water; genuflect and kneel in a pew. Then quietly wait and allow the Lord to love you and minister to your needs. Feel free to sit at any time. You can talk with Him, tell Him you love Him and thank Him. You can ask Jesus for help or share your worries and your joys. You can read the Bible, pray a rosary, or do whatever type of quiet, prayerful devotion that suits you before Our Lord. You can just sit and say nothing, simply keeping him company. Don't let worries over how to pray stop you from coming, just being there will have an effect on you!
